

# George Fox Tennis Center COVID Guidelines

**Opening Date: Saturday, June 13**

## **Physical Distancing and Occupancy**

1. Classes (and online registration) will be limited to 12 participants or fewer.
  - a. The existing online registration system will continue to be used for registration purposes.
2. Class schedules and court reservations will be created with a minimum of 10 minutes in-between all classes. Participants will be instructed to not arrive earlier than 5 minutes prior to class or court reservation time. The intention is to avoid overlaps and decrease the chances of exceeding the 25 person limit put forth by the State of Oregon.
3. Physical distancing protocol of six feet will be enforced at all times. During classes, rubber lines normally used as targets will be used to space allocated lines of people, etc.
4. One way traffic flow using the southwest doors as the entry point and the northwest doors as the exit point. Will post signage indicating flow of traffic.

## **Operations**

1. 1. Users of the facility will be encouraged to bring their own filled water bottles with them to the facility. There are no water fountains located in the facility.
2. Balls will be cleaned and limited after every lesson with a special nylon cleaner specifically for the fabric on tennis balls. Balls will be limited to the lesson and court at hand, meaning no sharing of balls between courts & classes whatsoever.
3. Public rentals will not be allowed to use tennis facility balls; participants must bring their own balls.
4. Signage will be posted throughout all facilities as follows:
  - a. Symptoms and stay home signage
  - b. Physical Distancing signage
  - c. Handwashing signage
  - d. Maximum occupancy
  - e. Hand Sanitizer-stand will be offered in and out of the facility for all participants.
5. All employees of the tennis center will wear a face mask per Oregon law if the physical distancing protocol of six feet cannot be maintained.

## **Cleaning and Disinfection**

1. The courts will be cleaned daily using the floor cleaning machine (auto scrubber) and a disinfectant that is included on the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved list for the SARS-CoV-2 virus that causes COVID-19.
2. Provide disinfectants that are included on the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved list for the SARS-CoV-2 virus that causes COVID-19 in spray bottles located by each court to be used to wipe down chairs and other equipment as needed.

### **User Screening**

1. Employee will conduct client screening prior to use of the facility:
  - a. Record contact information, date and time for facility use.
  - b. Ask screening questions such as:
    1. Have you had a new or worsening cough?
    2. Have you had a fever (temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or above)?
    3. Have you had shortness of breath?
    4. Have you been in close contact with anyone with these symptoms or anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

### **Staffing and Hours**

1. The tennis center and indoor track is never open for public rental, private lessons, or group lessons without an employee present. There is no need to set hours as lesson times and court rental times vary throughout the week.
